Through this opportunity, the intern will:

- Gain real-world experience through front-line and mentorship exposure, in the field of outdoor recreation and environmental education.
- Develop and facilitate experiences through the lens of the benefits-based planning model.
- Coordinate with partnered environmental agencies to create learning opportunities for youth participants.
- Develop and refine professional human relations and interpersonal skills.
- Obtain American Canoe Association Instructor Certification in various paddlesports disciplines.
- Create a welcoming and safe atmosphere for youth participants between the ages of 12 & 17.

GENERAL INFORMATION & REQUIREMENTS

- Interns will be under the supervision of a Paddle-N-More mentor.
- Must be prepared to work outdoors in aquatic settings in a range of weather conditions.
- Be able to manage groups of participants on and off the water.
- Must have a growth mindset and work well in a team-oriented atmosphere.
- Must be able to provide personal transportation.
- Minimum age 18.
- Complete all requirements set forth by the college or university to complete the internship.
- If offered the position, interns must undergo and pass a background check.
